

EASY CRUSTLESS BAKED CHEESECAKE

Ingredients

200g cream cheese, softened
100g full-fat cream, whipped
2 eggs
100g sugar
1 tsp vanilla extract
100g strawberries, sliced
100g raspberries, sliced
100g blueberries, sliced

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C (350°F).
2. In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese and sugar until smooth.
3. Add the eggs and vanilla extract, and beat until well combined.
4. Fold in the whipped cream.
5. Pour the mixture into a greased 20cm round springform pan.
6. Bake for 45 minutes.
7. Let the cheesecake cool in the pan for 1 hour.
8. Top with the sliced strawberries, raspberries, and blueberries.
9. Chill in the refrigerator for 2 hours before serving.










Digging Deep - 2nd Edition by Jade Davenport 9781776195596 | Jonathan Ball Publishers | History | TPB | R450

South Africa's mining journey began with the discovery of 'mountains of copper' in Namaqualand, laying the foundation of an industry that forever shaped the nation's destiny. Nowhere has a mineral revolution proved so influential in weaving a society's political, economic and social fabric.

Digging Deep explores South Africa's great mineral revolution – the lucky strikes and struggles of prospecting in the late 1800s, boom-and-bust towns in the Eastern Transvaal Goldfield, the dubious beginnings of the Witwatersrand, and visionary men like Cecil Rhodes, Alfred Beit, Barney Barnato, Sir Ernest Oppenheimer, Sammy Marks and Hans Merensky who shaped the industry.

Gold, diamonds, platinum, coal and minerals – the richest treasure trove in one country – transformed a colonial backwater into the greatest industrialised power on the African continent. In this second edition, Jade Davenport adds two chapters examining the era since democracy's advent when the mining industry underwent profound and distressing transformation.

Sy vlug na 'n afgesonderde kothuis in die Baviaanskloof, waar sy beplan om 'n einde aan alles te maak. Maar eers wil sy met volmaan bo-op die berg kom en vir outaas gelukkiger tye in herinnering roep.

Ook op die berg is die luperdwyfie Twee Kofie wie se een poot onlangs vergris is toe sy en haar opgeskote welpie uit 'n slagyster probeer loskom het. Ná dese skuil sy teen die kranse van Rooikloof waar sy alles in haar vermoë doen om te oorleef.




The Queen of South African romance Nivashni Nair Sukdhev returns with another story set in Rally.

And then there is Danny's life-changing encounter, in the darkened streets of wartime London, with a wryly cynical, battle-scarred officer. In the midst of the greatest conflict in history, facing the wild beauty of 'the abyss of unmeaning,' Danny discovers the power of love, between friends, family – and even foes.
